

Born in Moscow in 1972, Vsevolod Dvorkin has studied with Vera Gornostaeva and Natalia Troull at Moscow Tchaikovsky Conservatory where he graduated with distinction in 1995. He has participated in numerous competitions in Italy and Germany winning top prizes as well as a scholarship in 1994 which gave him the opportunity to study in Italy under Lazar Berman at the "Accademia Pianistica Incontri col Maestro" in Imola and under Vincenzo Balzani at the Milan Conservatory. After his debut as soloist in "Sala Verdi" of Milan in 1998 he has performed in both solo and chamber music recital as well as with internationally acclaimed orchestras all over the world. He has worked with a variety of musicians as well as with numerous chamber ensembles. Dvorkin teaches piano at Modena conservatory of music and gives worldwide master classes. He recorded the Stradivarius Schumann Quartet Op.47 and the "Recitarsuonando" with Sonia Bergamasco for Raitrade as well as some chamber repertoire works with the violist Natalia Anikeeva for Croatian Radio HRT. Dvorkin has been member of the jury of various international competitions (Verbania, Valsesia Musica, Liszt in Parma, Città di Pavia, etc.). He has also participated in the New Names International program and in numerous festivals in Europe and Japan.
