

Hubert Stuppner graduated (major piano) from “Monteverdi” conservatory of music in Bolzano and later he got the doctorate in musicology at Padua University. He has also studied composition and has attended the Darmstadt Summer courses held by Karlheinz Stockhausen, Mauricio Kagel, György Ligeti and Iannis Xenakis. He has been professor at Bolzano conservatory and has worked at “Canneti” Institute in Vicenza as well. A few of his works have been awarded in Italy and abroad. He founded the “Bolzano Contemporary Music International Festival”. He has been director of Bolzano conservatory and of “Busoni” International Piano Competition. He has also been artistic director of “Haydn” orchestra of Bolzano and Trento. Many worldwide famous music academies often invite him to hold seminars and lectures. In 2014 he was awarded the “Puncetto d’Oro” Prize by Associazione Culturale Valsesia Musica.
